

# BRECKLAND MODEL AERO CLUB

## Club rules

- 1) All B.M.F.A. rules apply.
- 2) **The frequency board must be used at all times.**  
**Your peg must be placed on the appropriate frequency before switching on transmitter.**  
**Remove peg from board after flight**
- 3) All novice pilots are to be under the supervision of experienced Member until deemed confident to fly solo
- 4) Pits area as laid out on the runway map, with designated areas for set up, engine testing, and flight line safety officer to advice as required.
- 5) Take off/landings requirements are to be directed by the Safety officer in regards wind directions on the day.
- 6) The pits area is classed as a NO FLY ZONE as laid down on Flying sight map
- 7) The scout club complex is to be classed as a NO FLY ZONE
- 8) **Pilots must be in pilot box whilst flying**
- 9) All aircraft are NOT to be taxied in or out of the pits area under any circumstances
- 10) Any in flight emergency is to be declared immediately, and is A priority call, all pilots are to clear runway until the emergency is cancelled
- 11) All take off; landings and dead stick emergencies must be called At all times
- 12) The safety officer is responsible for the general pits area, and Is required that all engine run ups are carried out in the Designated area at all times whenever practical.
- 13) Conduct, any misconduct of the club rules/BMFA rules may Be implemented by any club member through the chairman on the Day disciplinary action will be implemented as follows,
  - 1) A verbal warning will be given in the first instance.
  - 2) A ban from the flying sight as deemed fit by a club meeting, This will be in the form of a letter to the member concerned
  - 3) A total ban from the club with no refund of club fees.

NOTE Any 2 club members may implement disciplinary action at  
The flying sight persistent offenders will be asked to cease  
Flying for the day

## APPEALS

Any member may appeal to any ban at any monthly  
Meeting, and must appear in person to state his case
